Team Selection

This is an impartial process led by the team captain in conjunction with the Performance Manager. Selection is based on a number of factors including ranking and knowledge of players – reliability, foreseeable physical fitness, conduct, and a player's ability to work within the team.

An important consideration when making selections is a player's doubles record, which will be determined through their ranking, the number of events played, performance and results.

The team captain will also assess player's doubles potential though county training practices.

Wildcards can be selected at any time, (i.e. at selection meetings, invited to attend training sessions, asked to participate in a play-off match(es) or be selected as a result of training sessions).The Team Captain will make final decision.

Selection is based on a combination of direct entry players and wildcards as follows:

The captain reserves the right to change the team if a player does not attend any of the arranged practice sessions

All of the selections including the wild cards must be justified through the player demonstrating loyalty, commitment, attitude and team spirit towards all county events and activities relevant to the player.

10U/9U Team Selection

This is an impartial process led by the team captain, county coaches and performance manager. Selection is based on a number of factors such as knowledge of players, their commitment to game development for the future and performance in competition. - reliability, foreseeable physical fitness, conduct, and a player's ability to work within the team.
