Middlesex Tennis Sustainability Project

Calling All Clubs and Parks!

Middlesex Tennis is looking for all our venues – our clubs and parks - across Middlesex to join us on a journey towards a more sustainable future for tennis. Working with a small team of volunteers - the Middlesex Tennis Sustainability Team, we've developed a 'greenprint' to help Middlesex Tennis and its venues make sustainable changes, and we need your help to implement this.

Why do we believe that this is important?

We're sure that the big issues of today, including climate change, resource scarcity, consumerism and biodiversity loss, won't have escaped you. You may feel that, as an individual, or as a venue, you can't make much of an impact, but the reality is that **you can**. If we all step up to make even small changes, *together we can make a difference*.

We recognise that running a tennis venue is a significant responsibility and takes a huge amount of time and effort, especially for those venues run by volunteers. Our aim is to create an approach that inspires our venues and members to take part, with the associated benefits of feeling that you and your members can make a difference by taking pride in the positive changes being made, or from the money that the venue saves by taking some of the steps we are suggesting.

How can venues take part?

Caring for the planet is everyone's responsibility. However, it's our junior players who have the most to gain (or lose) and who are often the most passionate about the issues involved. We'd like to propose that you give your juniors the agency to form, or be part of, a Green Team of sustainability champions to lead this initiative at each venue, with the support of your committee.

We've come up with an Information Pack and a one pager Timeline to help your Green Team support your venue in making progress:

How is this relevant to our venue?

We recognise that not all venues are the same, which means that different venues may have different areas of focus and impact. To help you decide where your efforts might best be focused, the Action Plan in the 'Rationale for Change' for each poster starts to categorise these actions according to effort and potential impact by using two categories:

Big Hitters – These are actions which we believe will help you to make the biggest impact. For example, switching your energy provider to renewable energy will result in a big reduction of emissions by avoiding the burning of fossil fuels.

Volley Winners – Actions which may have a lower impact individually but will contribute to the overall sustainability of the venue and may also prove useful e.g. connecting a water butt to your drainpipe to use to water plants. Amongst these, there are a few quick wins, which are easy actions that everyone can take without giving them much thought or effort e.g. switching off lights when not in use.

We are all on a journey!

This may feel like a cliché, but we are all on this journey together. Change takes time, but the main thing is that we all try to make a difference. Together, we can make more progress as a group or by collaborating with other initiatives, such as the Middlesex Tennis Green Deal.
